

Year 3 Trip to Sutton Hoo

Dear Parents/Guardians

As part of our summer topic, Anglo-Saxons, Year 3 will this term be visiting Sutton Hoo. During the day the children will learn about the story of Sutton Hoo having an opportunity to explore the burial mounds.

The trip will take place on Tuesday 25th June. Children will leave school at 8.45am and will arrive back before the end of the school day. The visit leaders will be Mrs Bally and Mrs Redbond, who will be accompanied by other members of staff.

School uniform must be worn on the day, and a coat and good walking shoes will be required. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, preferably in a named plastic carrier bag. Those who receive a free school lunch can have one made up for them by the canteen – please indicate on the slip below if you would like us to arrange for this.

We are asking for a contribution of £10.80 which will cover the entrance fee and cost of the coach. Payment may be made to your child's teacher or the school office and should accompany the returned parental consent form which is attached. Unfortunately, if we do not get every child's parental consent form they will not be able to come on the trip. Any parents experiencing difficulties paying should speak to Mr Wood as we want all children to enjoy this experience.

We will also be reminding the children of the need for a high standard of behaviour throughout the day but would ask parents to reinforce this prior to the visit. Should behaviour fall below an acceptable level then parents may be asked to collect their child.
