### School Uniform

At Clifford Road Primary we pride ourselves on keeping school uniform costs as low as possible. This is why we do not allow outlets in town to sell our uniform and have colours that can easily be bought at supermarkets or online. Many school uniform items can be purchased at the school office or online at [www.stparent.co.uk](http://www.stparent.co.uk)

#### Tightening up on uniform:

We are flexible in many areas with the aim to keep costs down. However, please be aware of the areas we would like to tighten up on so that we do not have too much variation in uniform:

- **Bottle green** is the school colour for sweatshirts, cardigans or jumpers. This colour is widely available from supermarkets and can be bought at our school office; please do not buy any other variation of green. No grey jumpers/cardigans please.
- From September, we will expect children to wear **black footwear** – shoes or trainer style shoes. No brightly coloured trainers for general wear please.
- It has always been the policy that **NO jewellery** is allowed. Please do not send your child into school with rings, bracelets (of any kind) and necklaces; it is upsetting for the children when we have to ask them to take them off.

I hope the information below is useful to you in clarifying the school uniform policy.

Children are expected to wear the following uniform: -

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• White blouse/ polo shirt</li> <li>• Grey or black skirt/pinafore/trousers</li> <li>• Bottle green sweatshirt/jumper/ cardigan</li> <li>• <b>Black</b> school shoes (<b>black</b> trainer style shoes are allowed)</li> <li>• Warmer months: Green &amp; white gingham dress. Sandals with socks can be worn, but no flip flops or clog style shoes</li> <li>• Swimming kit: one piece swimming costume (no bikinis), swimming hat and towel</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• White shirt/ polo shirt</li> <li>• Grey or black trousers/shorts</li> <li>• Bottle green sweatshirt/jumper</li> <li>• <b>Black</b> school shoes (<b>black</b> trainer style shoes are allowed)</li> <li>• Warmer months: sandals with socks can be worn, but no flip flops or clog style shoes</li> <li>• Swimming kit: swimming trunks (no loose shorts), swimming hat and towel</li> </ul>

**PE Kit:** - children must have a PE kit consisting of green or black shorts (no logos), white T-shirt and trainers (any colour) or plimsolls, and plain joggers for outdoor games in colder months.

ALL SCHOOL UNIFORM AND PE/SWIMMING KITS MUST BE LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME AND CLASS

**Jewellery:** - No jewellery is allowed other than watches and small earrings - studs or small sleepers.
