

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our topic on 'Minibeasts' a trip to Easton Farm Park has been arranged for the pupils of R1 & R2, during which they will follow a trail, take part in a minibeast hunt and look at the animals and plants. This has been booked for Tuesday 5th July. Children will leave school at 9:45am and will return by 3:20pm. The visit leaders will be Mrs Roberts and Mrs Foreman. Teaching Assistants who will have responsibilities as group supervisors will also accompany us and we would welcome adults as helpers for the trip. During the visit the children will not be unaccompanied at any time although there may be occasions when they are accompanied solely by parent helpers. The children will travel by two coaches provided by Forget-Me-Not travel and throughout the journey the children will be covered by the County's school visits and journeys insurance policy. If we need to contact you during the day, we will do so via the contact details held in school. If medical help is required we will assume that your child's medical requirements and doctor's surgery information remain as noted on the annual data return sheet. If any of these details have changed or will be different on the day of the trip, please inform us in writing.

The cost for this trip, per child, is £10.00 which will cover the cost of the coach and the entrance fee to Easton Farm Park. **If your child is currently eligible for free school meals (this is different from the 'universal free school meals' that all children in Reception and KS1 receive) the cost of the trip is £5.** Please see the office staff if you are unsure as to whether your child qualifies. If you are volunteering as a parent helper there will be a cost of £5 to cover the cost of the coach. Payments may be made to the office, in a marked envelope, via your child's teacher, and should be returned with the permission slip. This trip is not suitable for parent helpers to bring young children.

School jumper/cardigans should be worn on the day, with long trousers/jeans and sturdy (closed in) shoes. The children may also bring spending money of up to £4. All children require a packed lunch for this trip. **If you would like a free packed lunch provided by the school, you need to order this in advance by Friday 24th June on the form below** however please provide a drink. More details of what we will do on the day and the final arrangements will follow nearer the time.

We would really appreciate your help on this trip and aim to have 1 adult accompanying 2 children. We are all really looking forward to the day and hope some of you will be able to join in the fun!
