Years 2 & 3 Trip to the Children's Bookshow - David Litchfield at the Wolsey Theatre
The Bear and the Piano/Grandad's Secret Giant

We are very excited to let you know that we have arranged for the children in years two and three to attend the Children's Bookshow featuring the author David Litchfield at the Wolsey Theatre Ipswich on Thursday 19th October.

David Litchfield is a writer and illustrator and his first book, *The Bear and the Piano* might be familiar to your child. It won the 2016 Waterstone's Children's Book Prize for Best Illustrated Book.

David will talk about his journey from being a comic-book-making child to becoming a critically-acclaimed author and illustrator. He will show a range of his illustrations, tell us about his work, read his wonderful stories - and you'll even be lucky enough to see him draw live!

We value enrichment activities such as these very highly; a live bookshow is something that we feel every child should experience and have chosen to fund this trip in its entirety at a cost of £5 per child. This trip is a local visit trip and therefore does not require parental permission.

The performance starts at 11am and will last about one hour. In line with our healthy schools policy, we will be walking to the theatre and back again, leaving school at 10am and returning towards the latter part of the lunch break. Children will still have the usual lunch options that day; however, it will not be practical to arrange for home dinners.

Children will be required to wear school uniform and will be walking even if it is raining so please send them to school on that day in a coat appropriate for the conditions on the day.

The trip leader will be your child's class teacher. Several other members of staff will also be accompanying the children. **If you are interested in accompanying us on this trip or walking the children there and back but not attending the event, please contact Michele Quinton at the front office or text your name to her at school by Friday 13th October.**

During the visit the children will not be unaccompanied at any time. We will be reminding the children of the need for a high standard of behaviour throughout the trip, but would ask parents to reinforce this prior to the visit. Should behaviour fall below an acceptable level then parents may be asked to collect their child.

If we need to contact you during the day, we will do so via the contact details held in school. If medical help is required we will assume that your child's medical requirements and doctor's surgery information remain as noted on the annual data return sheet. If any of these details have changed or will be different on the day of the trip, please inform us in writing. Should you need to make emergency contact with your child during the morning, this should be done by phoning the school on 01473251605.
