Year Six Residential Trip September 2018 - For Children currently in Year 5

Thank you for your patience while we sorted out the finer details of the trip next September. We can now confirm that the first deposit window has now closed and we have made a booking with Kingswood for 42 children and 5 adults to travel to the Isle of Wight. We are thrilled that so many children are able to come along. We are looking forward to taking them; we know they will all get so much out of it.

The details of the trip will be:

- The trip will be to the **Kingswood Study Centre on the Isle of Wight from Monday 10th to Friday 14th September 2018**
- Following the Adventure Activities week, this includes a range of individual and team challenges at the main site and on the beach. Full details of the company, centre and activities can be found online at www.kingswood.co.uk
- Our confirmation has fixed the price with both Kingswood and the coach company; we can now confirm that the total cost of the trip will be **£302 per child**.

There will be 5 adults accompanying the children and we will decide who they will be nearer to the time, usually we try to make sure that they include those closely involved in teaching the year group involved and at least one member of our Senior Leadership Team.

We are happy to take instalments of any size throughout the year and will record these on your payment details on your child's payment account, which can be accessed online (although we hold separate records here of payments so don't worry if you cannot go online). You are of course welcome to pay in instalments of any amount subject to meeting the **deadlines of non-refundable payments** as below:

Initial deposit = £40 ALREADY PAID

Friday 2nd February = a further £120

Friday 22nd June = the balance of £142 (making a final total of £302)

We will contact you later in the school year to give you updates on your balance, in the meantime if you have any questions please do not hesitate to catch either myself or Mr Wood around school.
