Sports Premium Grant expenditure: report for Parents and Governors 2013-2014

The Sports Premium is additional funding provided to schools for the academic years 2013 / 2014 and 2014 / 2015 to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and sport in Primary Schools. This funding is provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and is ring fenced. Therefore, it can only be spent on provision of PE and sports in school.

The school wants to ensure that this money is used to enable our pupils to have increased opportunities to participate in sport, to attain well and to reach their full potential.
